Making Plans, a Mock Clinic, the Real Thing

Making Plans involved frequent trips back and forth to Mexico over the past few months to coordinate with local and US pastors, doctors, dentists and government officials; to finalize all contacts and details; to train locals to serve at the clinics and for follow-up with the patients.

The Mock Clinic will be Nov. 22-23 at Piedra Angular Church in Hermosillo. All the medical and dental equipment will be set up, then the medical staff and trainees will run through the "drills," practicing on each other to work out any glitches, and organizing the flow of everything. The primary dentists will be Dr. Bruce White and Dr. Mario Garzón, the local dentist who has done clinics like this for over 40 years.

The Real Thing

The actual clinic will be January 10-14, with 2 days at Piedra Angular in Hermosillo and 1 day at a local clinic in San Pedro del Saucito. When patients arrive, their blood pressure, glucose and oxygen levels will be checked, then they'll be triaged to get the best service.

Three Exciting Goals behind this and other clinics:

1. There will be ongoing follow-up for health education and spiritual outreach with all who attend the clinics.
2. Many of the volunteers coming from the US are dental students or colleagues of Dr. White. Some may not be Christians so the believers from Mexico and the US will be "salt and light" to those from both sides of the border who don't yet know Jesus as Lord and Savior. A great example of cross-cultural missions and mutual evangelism, enabling both cultures to grow spiritually!
3. While doctors, dentists and hygienists are seeing patients, other team members can offer classes (on parenting, for example) & activities for waiting families & children.
